

## Bitesize Briefing Local Area National Indicators (April 2008)

What follows is how the targets relevant to Third Sector Adult education fared in the recent process for inclusion in Local Area Agreements. This may help you put Derbyshire and Derby's LAA into a broader perspective.

### Main targets nationally:

1 <sup>st</sup>	16-19 NEET (NI 117)	117 LAAs
6 <sup>th</sup>	Working-age population at level 2 or above (NI 163)	92 LAAs
8 <sup>th</sup>	People believing different people get on well (NI 1)	87 LAAs
14 <sup>th</sup>	Adult participation in sport (NI 8)	76 LAAs
15 <sup>th</sup>	Re-offending rates (NI 30)	76 LAAs

### National also rans:

Employment rates (NI 151) & Levels of benefit claimants (NI 152) were high priorities in a minority of cases

Inclusion of adults with learning difficulties (NI 146) & Employment for people with mental health difficulties (NI 150) were fairly strong runners

Participation in volunteering (N16) and a Thriving Voluntary Sector (N17) were the VCS front-runners.
